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# Introduction

**T**he subject of alien life has fascinated thousands throughout history. For some, the strange presence of ancient structures that defy natural explanations seems to support the idea that Earth has been visited by beings from other worlds or planetary systems. Unidentified flying objects (UFOs) are part of modern consciousness, evoking images of streamlined spaceships, long-fingered extraterrestrials (ETs), and scary cyborgs. Places such as Roswell, New Mexico, and Stonehenge in England are hotspots for an ongoing preoccupation with the existence of extraterrestrial beings who might have visited Earth.

And, indeed, it does appear unlikely that humans are alone in the universe. The mathematical laws of probability suggest—almost require—the presence of other intelligent beings somewhere in the cosmos. By early 2012, observatories around the world had detected seven hundred planets in solar systems similar to ours, and statistical estimates propose that two-thirds of the stars in the Milky Way have at least one Earth-sized planet.\* To think that we are the only beings in the universe endowed with consciousness and self-determination is naïve.

From the beginning of recorded history, religious traditions have contemplated the involvement of aliens in human affairs. In essence, what are the angels of the Judeo-Christian Scriptures but aliens? Was not Jesus Himself a being from another plane or cosmology?

This book is about angels—what they are, what they do, and their participation throughout history according to the Bible. If you believe in the Bible, you will find that what follows in this book does not contradict the Scriptures. If you are not a believer, you may at least consider whether a higher plane of existence inhabited by other intelligent beings would explain quite well some of the unlikely qualities of the human race's history.

For now, they waited; it would take several generations for their services to become increasingly necessary.

Although all classes of angels were represented in the large group, warriors were the most abundant. In a heaven populated by loving beings, their presence still seemed strange; but the rebellion had begun, and this new class of angels was now a necessity. Yes, the inconceivable power of the Word could protect the entire universe, but He was now concentrating His immense energy on the task of creating a new world.

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In essence, the Word was transforming His energy into matter on a cosmic scale. Einstein's famous formula  $E = mc^2$ , which suggested the connection between energy and matter, would later throw light on this process and provide the basis for human discoveries in quantum physics and antimatter.

The Bible suggests that this energy was felt in the form of vibrations that initiated tremendous physical and chemical processes; the vibrations pulsed in precise wave patterns that echoed as words throughout the galaxy and expanded as ever-widening, concentric circles of light that reached to the farthest ends of the universe. From their stations several light-years from Earth, the angels beheld the great opera of Creation. It was not their first creation event, but this one was special for several reasons. This planet was being created even as a terrible conflict had erupted in heaven. The risk was real. For the first time, there was discord in heaven. For the first time the angels had to face deception and rebellion in conjunction with the creative process. The revolt had to be contained. The new class of loyal warrior angels had protected other worlds from the deceptive invasion, but now a new world would also have to pass the test. The creative symphony of the Word shook the universe. With a burst of sound and energy, He commenced to ready the planet for carbon-based life. First, He adjusted the distance between Earth and the sun; He also had to fine-tune the orbits of the entire solar system, including Earth's small satellite, the moon. Humans would have to exist in time and space. Their living cycles would be governed by the sidereal movements. This would bring order and periodicity to their existence.

God had great plans for His new creation. It would receive from Him a vital energy that could continue throughout eternity. (The initial spark was so powerful that the first man would live 930 years even after the contamination of sin.) That same spark is the energy that literally powers the angels, but their lives are constantly renewed by God's presence. As most living organisms receive strength and health from solar energy, the angels renew their energy from the infinite Source of divine glory.

Angels are not gods. They should not be worshiped, nor do they want to be. They are created beings as are humans, but on a superior level of existence. When the eighth psalm says that humans were created a little lower than the angels, it is not speaking of men in their current condition but of the first man, Adam. The first man was very different from all other men since. The Bible says that he was "very good" (Genesis 1:31). Indeed, he was perfect. He was the true king of all creation. The first man was not a weakling, subject to dangers posed by animals more powerful than he. His body was of majestic proportions, much larger and powerful than that of modern man. His limbs moved with the perfect precision of a being newly created in the image of God. His dominion over nature was physical, mental, and spiritual, as long as he enjoyed intimacy with the Creator.

No one truly knows what man's potential would have been if he hadn't fallen. Because the loyal angels have retained their connection to the Creator as His agents, they wield fantastic powers.

For example, the angels seem to have dual natures that manifest in both physical and nonmaterial forms. They have bodies similar to those

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of humans, but they do not have our limitations. They seemingly can enter an energy state that allows them to travel from one place to another through walls and space and time. They can take invisible forms, although sometimes their presence is felt and they can be seen by humans. They can communicate with and guide the minds of physical beings who inhabit Earth. They are smart, very smart. They are independent, but they are also social beings who enjoy the society of heaven.

Do angels have wings? The question is a complicated one. No one knows for sure if angels actually have wings, but the Bible often presents them as winged beings. On the other hand, it appears that the angels who took physical form to visit Abraham and those who appeared to the disciples in the New Testament had no wings. For ancient peoples, wings were the only known means of transporting a living being through the air, so it's not unusual that the Scriptures would represent angels—flying beings—as having wings.

Wings, at least, have a symbolic value. For warrior angels, they seem to serve as protection; for guardian angels, wings provide an image of shelter and refuge. The Bible represents even God as having wings. "I will be safe under His wings," wrote the psalmist (see Psalm 57:1).

From a distance, squads of angels watched as the Word turned Earth into a living habitat for humans and other life-forms. That first day, when the astronomical clock was turned on, time began to be measured from the perspective of the new planet. The set of nine planetary bodies began orbiting around the sun. Five days passed while the Word was adorning the blue-green sphere revolving in His hands like a potter decorates a pot on the wheel.

On the sixth day, there was a pause. The Word momentarily entered the creation stage in person. The hands that had held the entire globe only moments before, now took on a quasi-human scale.
