Here is an example. The first missing word in the story is Luke 5:1—word 23. The King James Version of that text says, "And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret." You count to the twenty-third word of that text and discover that it is *lake*. Then you write *lake* on the blank line. See what I mean? Work carefully because this is the only way you will uncover the secrets waiting just for you.

Then, color the picture! Use lots of greens, blues, reds, browns, yellows, and all of your favorites. Make your camp as beautiful as God created it to be.

Finally, don't forget to thank God for the wonderful world He made for you to enjoy.
